Dear ELI Members and Friends

I am pleased to embark on a second term as ELI President, following my reappointment in autumn 2023. Former Executive Committee members, Anne Birgitte Gammeljord (now 1st Vice-President), Prof Dr Pietro Sirena (now Treasurer), Prof Dr Teresa Rodrigues de las Herras Ballel, Dr Aneta Wiewiórowska-Domagalska and I, are joined by two new members: Sir Geoffrey Vos (Master of the Rolls and Head of Civil Justice in England and Wales), who was elected 2nd Vice-President, and Judge Sylvaine Peruzzetto-Poillot of the Cour de Cassation of France, in our quest to head this dynamic organisation.

Before turning to ELI's achievements in 2023, let me record my gratitude once again, both to former Lord Chief Justice of England and Wales, Lord John Thomas (ELI's former 1st Vice-President), and to Prof Dr Bénédicte Fauvarque-Cosson, now administratrice

générale of the Conservatory of Arts and Crafts (CNAM), for their services in advancing our shared goals. Both stepped down from the Executive in September 2023, but continue to support ELI in other capacities.

Among key developments in 2023 were the launches of Kick-Off Webinars (which revive efforts to strengthen Members Consultative Committees (MCCs)), High Level Fora (which seek to ensure that ELI's outputs are brought to the direct attention of members of the bar, bench and academia, lawmakers, policymakers and other important stakeholders working in the relevant field) and ELI Members' Day (which seeks to integrate the views of our Members in the identification of project topics). Further developments in 2023 are outlined in this Activity Report. I wish you an enjoyable read.

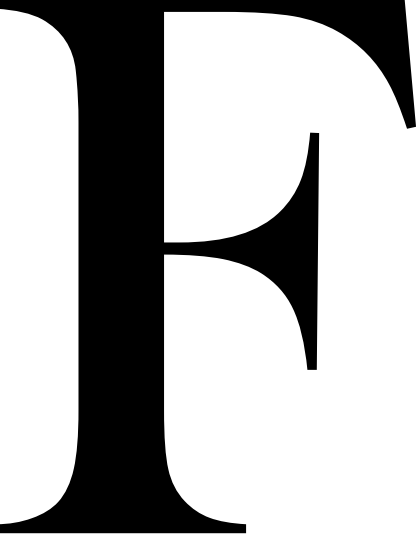


Top 5 Countries of Residence/Seats

ELI Funding

In 2023, ELI's total budget witnessed a 15% growth from the preceding year and a 14% increase compared to 2021.

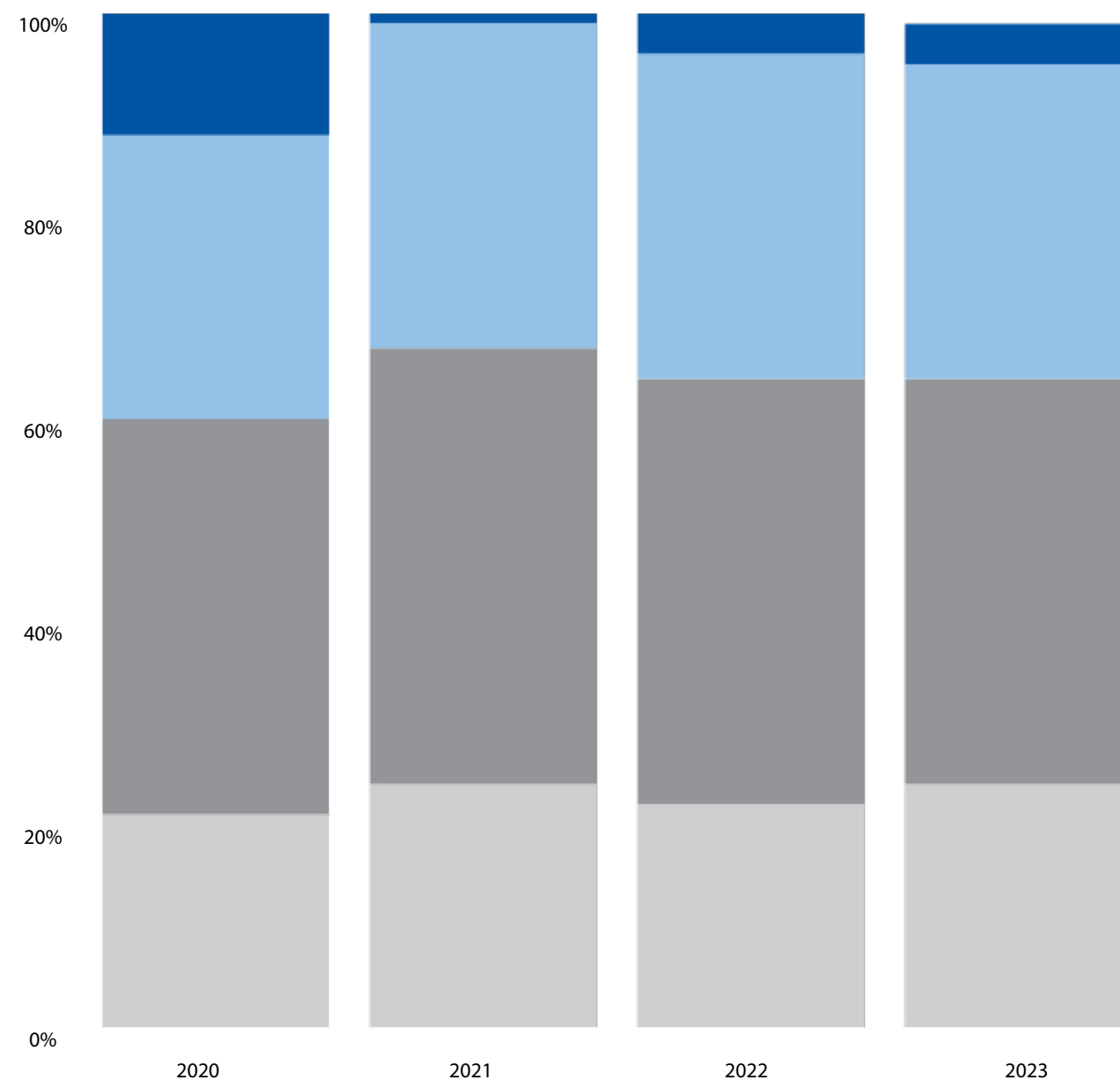
ELI Membership Fees constituted 24% of the Institute's funding (up from 22% in 2022). ELI recorded the increase in revenue, following its increase in Membership fees.

ELI's Operating Grant from the European Commission accounted for 31% of its total funding. Despite a marginal 1% decrease in the context of overall funding, the grant awarded in 2023 surpassed that of 2022 by EUR 10,000.

Funding from the **University of Vienna**, which has hosted the ELI Secretariat since 2011, constituted a substantial 40% of ELI's total funding in 2023 (down from 42% in 2022), due to the aforementioned increase in Membership fees. The actual amount awarded in 2023 was EUR 12,500 more than in 2022.

The joint ELI-University of Vienna Framework Cooperation Agreement was renewed for an additional four years (2023–2027), effective 2023. A 20% increase in funding was awarded for the period.

ELI also benefits from various **project-specific grants**.

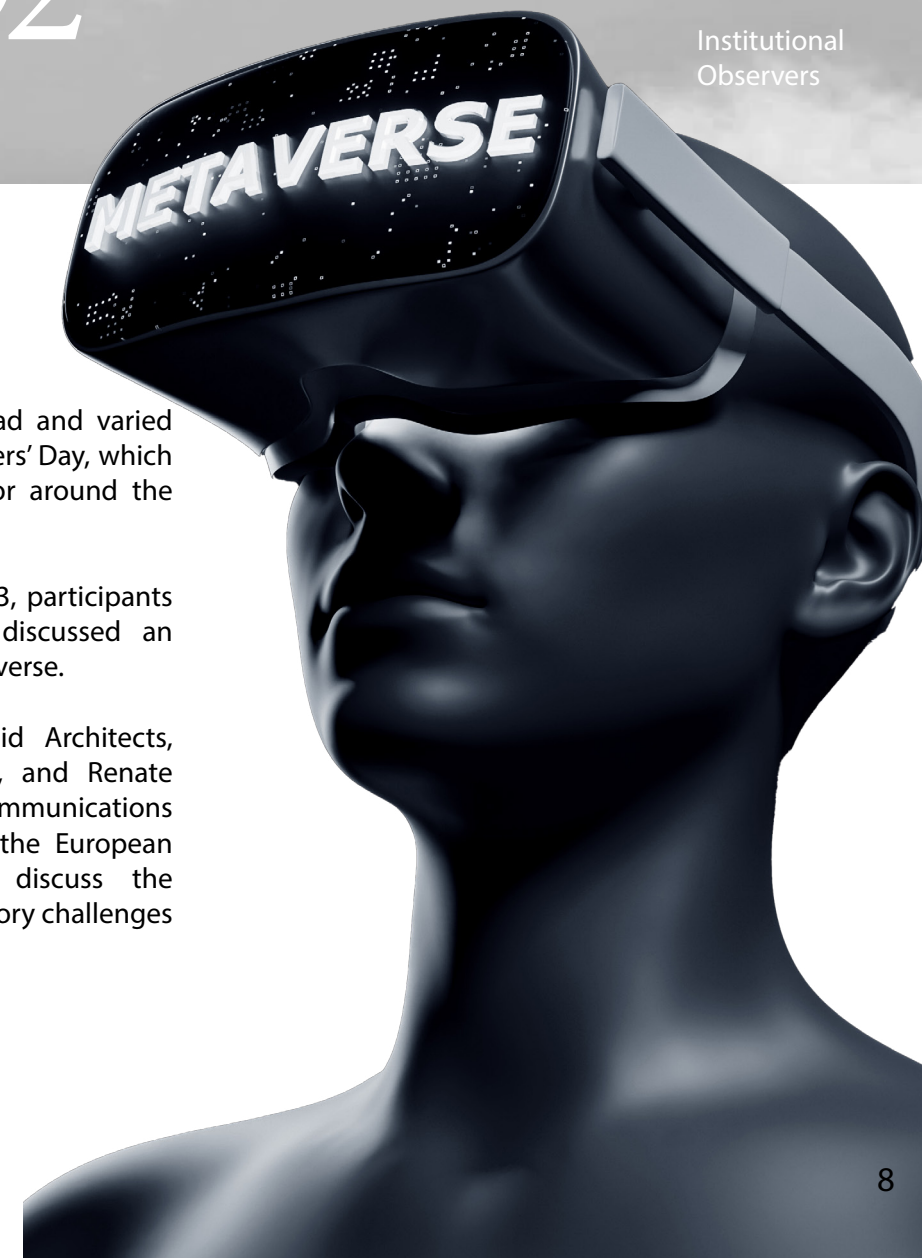
Membership

ELI Members' Day

To recognise the importance of its broad and varied Membership base, ELI launched a Members' Day, which will be celebrated annually online on or around the occasion of ELI's anniversary.

On ELI first Members' Day of 1 June 2023, participants reflected on ELI's achievements and discussed an emerging legal topic: the Law in the Metaverse.

Representatives from Meta, Zaha Hadid Architects, Deloitte, prominent legal professionals, and Renate Nikolay, Deputy Director-General for Communications Networks, Content, and Technology at the European Commission, convened remotely to discuss the opportunities as well as emerging regulatory challenges for the field. Projects led by Members and partners undergo extensive consultation within ELI's broad network. ELI therefore welcomes the expansion of its Membership base.





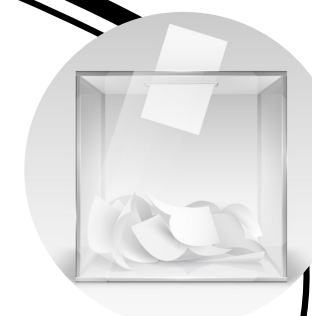

A Unique Platform

2011

In May, the University of Vienna won the tender to host the ELI Secretariat. In July, the Inaugural Congress of ELI took place in Paris. In November, then Commissioner of Justice Viviane Reding opened the ELI Secretariat.

2014

ELI published a Statement on Collective Redress and Competition Damages Claim, a supplement to its Statement on the Proposal for a Regulation on a Common European Sales Law and a Response to the European Commission's Public Consultation on the Review of the EU Copyright Rules.

2016

ELI published a Statement on the European Commission's proposed Directive on the Supply of Digital Content to Consumers.

2018

The agreement between ELI and the University of Vienna was extended until 2023. ELI also published the ELI Statement on the Principled Relationship of Formal and Informal Justice through the Courts and Alternative Dispute Resolution.

2020

ELI published its Model Rules on Online Platforms, the ELI Report on Protection of Adults in International Situations and the ELI Principles for the COVID-19 Crisis.

2022

ELI five outputs were published, namely, the ELI Report on Business and Human Rights, the ELI Model Rules on Impact Assessment of Algorithmic Decision-Making Systems Used by Public Administration, the ELI Principles on the Use of Digital Assets as Security, the ELI Report on Freedom of Expression as a Common Constitutional Tradition in Europe, and the ELI Draft of a Revised Product Liability Directive. Additionally, the following Responses to the Public Consultations were published: on Civil Liability, the Cross-Border Protection of Vulnerable Adults, on the Sustainable Consumption of Goods. A Feedback on the Commission's Proposal for a Revised Product Liability Directive was also issued. In addition, ELI published a Council Resolution on Ukraine and the Innovation Paper on Automated Decision-Making in the EU. In 2022, the agreement between ELI and the University of Vienna was again extended (for the 2023–2027 period), with an increase in financial support.

2012

The ELI published its first Statement: Case-Overload at the European Court of Human Rights and the ELI Statement on the Proposal for a Regulation on a Common European Sales Law.

2015

The agreement between ELI and the University of Vienna was extended until 2019. A second Supplement on the Statement on Sales was issued.

2017

ELI published the Draft Legislative Proposal for the Prevention and the Resolution of Conflicts of Jurisdiction in Criminal Matters in the European Union, the ELI Statement on Detention of Asylum Seekers and Irregular Migrants and the Rule of Law and the ELI Instrument on Rescue of Business in Insolvency Law.

2019

The ELI Instrument on Empowering European Families: Towards More Party Autonomy in European Family and Succession Law was published.

2021

ELI celebrated its 10th anniversary.
