
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
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Impact Assessment Procedure











- 2. The report shall contain:
 - a. a description of the purpose and operation of the system, in particular: (...)
 - b. an assessment of the **performance**, **effectiveness and efficiency** of the system (...);
 - c. an assessment of the specific and systemic **impact** of the system **on**:
 - i. fundamental or other individual rights or interests ...
 - ii. <u>democracy</u>, societal and environmental well-being;
 - iii. the administrative authority itself, ...
 - d. an assessment of the measures taken to ensure:
 - i. maximisation of benefits ...;
 - ii. <u>minimisation of identified risks</u> ...; (...)
 - e. (...) a concluding **determination of the risk level**;
 - [low/medium risk ⇔ high risk? ⇒ expert/public participation)
 - f. an **overall assessment** of the necessity and proportionality (...) and whether there are <u>reasonable</u> <u>alternatives</u> to the envisaged system;
 - g. a reasoned **statement on the legality** of the use of the system (...)





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














Clarifications responding to common questions and earlier feedback

- the Model Rules aim to balance innovation (i.e. spread of AI in administration) and risk management (which means some degree of bureaucracy)
- the Impact Assessment is not a licensing procedure and does not impose permit requirements for (private) Al
- independent supervisory authority oversees the use of ADMS by public authorities (Art. 15)
 - o makes recommendations to implementing authorities based on complaints (Art. 15(5), 16)
 - o appoints Expert Board members (Art. 10(6))
 - o provides a public online register of Impact Assessment Reports (Art. 15(4), 13(4))
- the Model Rules could be implemented by the EU, but also by Member States including their subdivisions or other European or non-European countries



Compatibility with the Draft Al Act

- The Model Rules complement the Draft Al Act, which does not provide for case-specific impact assessments
- Option 1: the EU could prescribe impact assessments for public administration
 - but questions of competence concerning the use of ADS by national public administration
- Option 2: integrate opening clauses into the Draft AI Act for Member States to establish impact assessments for the use of ADS by national public administration



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
