Elena Bargelli is Full Professor of Private Law and European Private Law and, previously, of Family Law, at the University of Pisa, where she coordinates the PhD Programme on 'Private law, comparative private law, labour law and European legal traditions'. She has been member of the Italian Banking and Financial Ombudsman (Milan, Italy) since 2018.

After she got her PhD in Private Law in Pisa, she spent a long time in Germany, where she had several research grants from the Max Planck Institute for foreign and private international law in Hamburg and, in 2008–2009, a *Stipendium* from the Humboldt Foundation.

From 2015 to 2021, she was a Member of the European Law Institute (ELI) Council and is currently the Co-Chair of ELI's Family and Succession Law Special Interest Group. From 2017 to 2019, she participated in the Advisory Committee of the ELI project on 'Protection of Adults in International Situations'. She is also a Member of the European Centre of Tort and Insurance Law (ECTIL); a member of the Advisory Board of the Institute for European Tort Law; an associate member of the International Association of Comparative Law (IACL); a member of the board of directors of the *Associazione Italiana di Diritto Civile* (Italian civil law association), of *Rivista di diritto civile* and *Pactum. Rivista di diritto dei contratti*. She is a member of the editorial board and referees committee of several other journals.

She is a Member of the board of (founding) directors of the series '*Argomenti di diritto civile*' (Publisher: Pacini giuridica) and Co-Editor of the series '*Land and Housing Law and Policy*' (Edward Elgar Publishing).

She is currently co-leading the project of the ELI on 'Extra-Judicial Administration of Justice in Cross-Border Family and Succession Matters', which received funding from the European Commission in 2022; she is also leading the project entitled 'Towards an Integrated Care System for the Population with Chronic Diseases, Multimorbidity, Frailty, and Polypharmacy', financed by the Italian Government in 2022.
