Description

The Draft Common Frame of Refence, which was rejected at a political level but still has an impact on legal scholarship, might have provided a facilitative framework for digital assets. The presentation will focus on whether the DCFR would have fulfilled that promise and why it proves so difficult to unify or even only harmonise areas of property law.

Prof. Sjef van ERP is co-founder and former (sole) Vice-President of the European Law Institute. He is currently head of the private law department at the University of Amsterdam and emeritus Professor at Maastricht University. He is President of the International Association of Legal Science and Vice-President of the International Institute for Justice Excellence.
